## Upper Murray Groundwater Management Area

### Background

Goulburn Murray Water (GMW) proposes to establish the Upper Murray Groundwater Management Area (GMA). It will include the Mitta Mitta River, Indi River and Corryong Creek catchments extending from Tallangatta across to Corryong and down to Omeo (see map attached). A Local Management Plan will be developed to describe how local groundwater resources are managed in the Upper Murray GMA.

### What will a Local Management Plan do?

The Local Management Plan will clearly document management objectives and water sharing arrangements for all users and the environment.

The intent of this Local Management Plan (the Plan) is to:

- Provide greater flexibility and certainty to groundwater users through transparent, cost effective and adaptive management rules;
- Support the sustainable development of groundwater resources; and
- Ensure environmental values supported by the region's groundwater are maintained.

### How will the Local Management Plan affect current groundwater licence holders?

The Plan will document rules which clearly explain how groundwater licence holders can maximise the use of their entitlements.

The rights of existing licence holders will be recognised in the Plan. There will be no reduction in groundwater entitlement.

### How will the Plan consider the environment?

The impacts of groundwater pumping on surface water systems, groundwater dependent ecosystems and groundwater quality will be considered and addressed during the development of the Plan.

### Who will be consulted?

The Plan will be developed by GMW in consultation with the Department of Environment and Primary Industries, the North Central Catchment Management Authority, Local Government, Urban Water Authorities, groundwater users and local communities.
