1. Goulburn-Murray Water (GMW) groundwater management information:

GMW is the licensing authority for groundwater in Northern Victoria. GMW actively manages access to groundwater resources using management plans, which are developed within defined Groundwater Management Units (GMU).

Each GMU is listed on the left hand side of the page. Click on each GMU to get access to:

- Management plans
- Annual reports and/or newsletters
- Relevant maps
- Hydrographs for key monitoring bores (updated quarterly)

2. Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning's (DELWP) Water Measurement Information System:

The Water Measurement Information System is the primary access point to search, discover, access and download surface water and groundwater monitoring data collected by DELWP and its partners.
